Winter 2020 Series

- Each lecture series has reached the half-way point
- MC's continue to stress, in their introductions, that Zoom sends out the link and that links are unique for each registrant.

Other topics

- Waiver letters (using the old format) have been sent to the Fall 2022 and the Winter 2023 speakers with 1 exception. (This Wednesday/Winter 2023 series has multiple speakers and we will work with this coordinator to get the Speaker's Agreements signed by each speaker.)
- The Agreement that we asked the speakers to sign is now titled the "Speakers Agreement".
- Mike Daley, our speaker for Fall 2022 has agreed to present his course titled "The Beatles and their Music" *either* in-person at Fairfield *or* on Zoom. If it is offered at Fairfield, we would offer the course again on Zoom, assuming there is enough interest.
- No response has been received from the Novel Spot about discussing the idea of a joint presentation about books at Fairfield (after Covid-19 restrictions are fully lifted).
